DGCA Written Examination Preparation – CPL / ATPL Admission Process



Enrollment Prerequisite:

- . Minimum age: 18 years
- . Must have completed 12th Standard or equivalent
- . Must be able to read, speak, write and understand the English language fluently
- . Must produce a leaving certificate or equivalent proof from the last attended school / college
- . Must produce a government ID proof like aadhar card / driving license / passport photo and address page
- . Obtain at least a second class medical certificate from an Aviation Medical Examiner
- . Must be of a good moral character
- . Must have a basic knowledge of mathematics and physics (12th standard level)

Enrollment Procedures:

Following documents required for admission.

1. Completed Application form
2. Photograph of your valid ID & address proof (this proof needs to be government issued, such as a passport, drivers license, Aadhar Card)
3. Photocopy of your 12th or equivalent mark sheet
4. Fees can be paid either by cash or wire transfer (for wire transfer your bank will give you this receipt upon completion of wire transfer).
